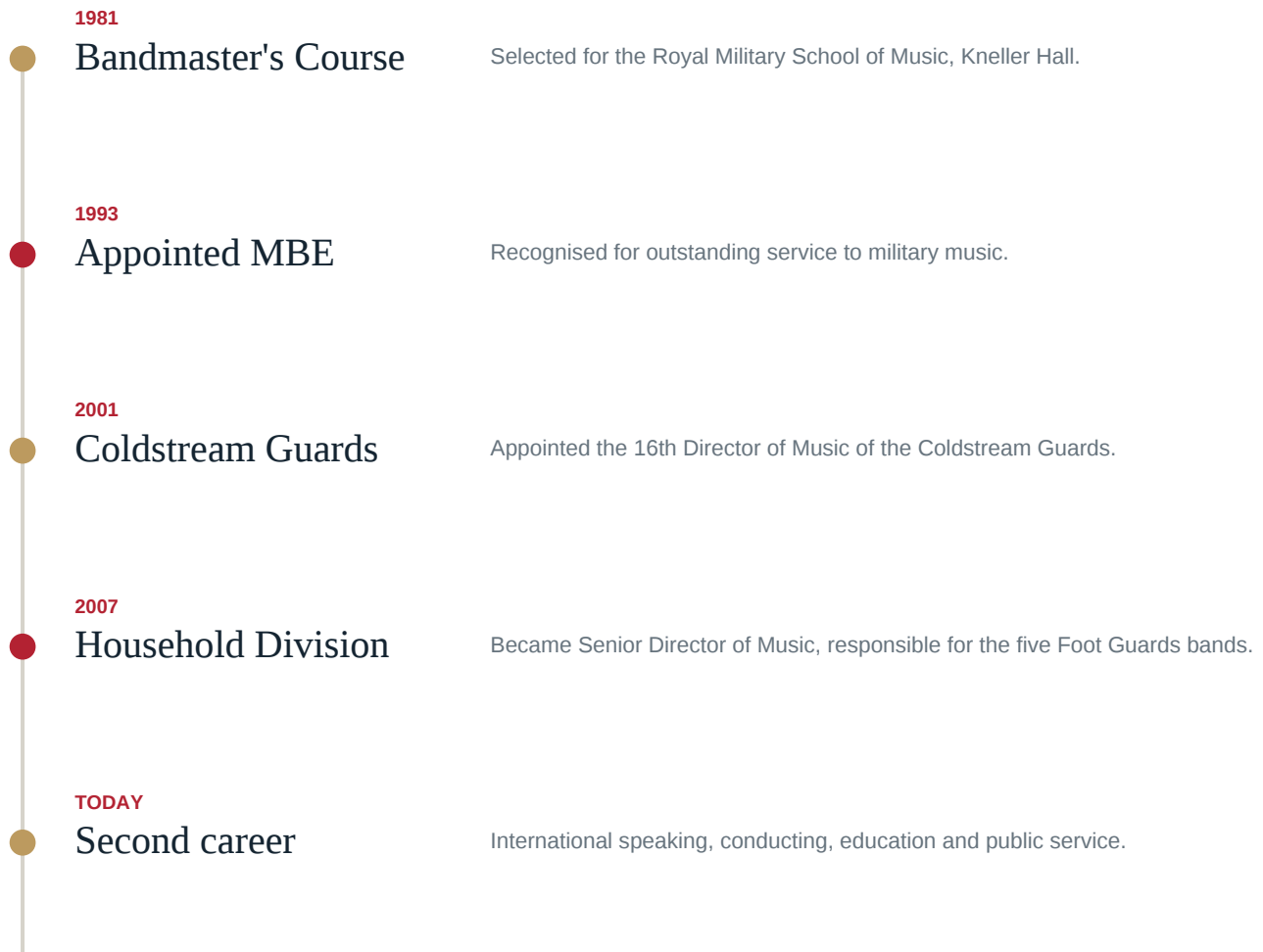

Graham began his professional life as a musician in the Royal Artillery Band and progressed through the Royal Military School of Music, appointments as a bandmaster and Director of Music, and ultimately to Senior Director of Music for the Household Division. He was appointed MBE in 1993 for outstanding service to military music. Since retiring from military service, he has worked internationally as a conductor, adjudicator, lecturer, clinician, recording consultant and educator.
